**CannaTrade 2006**  
**Traffic Plan for Assembly and Disassembly**

Dear Participants,

**We kindly request that you heed the following conditions:**

**Arrival**

- From March 23 to March 27, 2006, arrival at the exposition grounds occurs unidirectionally via Bolligenstrasse and the highway bridge.

**Payment of Deposit**

On Thursday March 23, Friday March 24 and Sunday March 26, 2006, a **deposit of Fr. 100.00** is to be paid upon arrival at the delivery ramp. The deposit will be refunded if the following conditions are met:

**Lorries:** Leave the grounds **2 hours after arrival at the latest**  
**Delivery Trucks:** Leave the grounds **1/2 hours after arrival at the latest**  
**Passenger Vehicles / Trailer** Leave the grounds **3/4 hour after arrival**

If these times for leaving the grounds are not honoured, the deposit will not be refunded! All vehicles that do not honour the deadline and are still on the grounds after another hour will be towed away at the owner's expense. The costs arising from this are the full responsibility of the exhibitor (Costs: Passenger Vehicle Fr. 350.00, Delivery Trucks and Lorries according to time involved).

**Parking Places During Assembly and Disassembly**

All vehicles having a maximum height of 2.1 meters must park in the

- Wankdorf Storage Hall.

**Delivery During the Exposition**

It is only possible to accept deliveries from 9:45 to 11:00 AM at the delivery hall 200.

We urgently request you to inform your drivers or delivery companies as well as your booth builders and to give them the necessary papers so that we can guarantee optimal arrival conditions for everyone involved. We are counting on your help and thank you in advance for your understanding.
